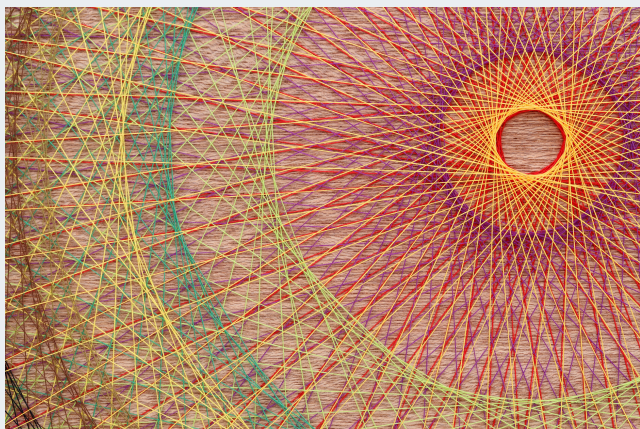
Anonymous: A Storytelling Project

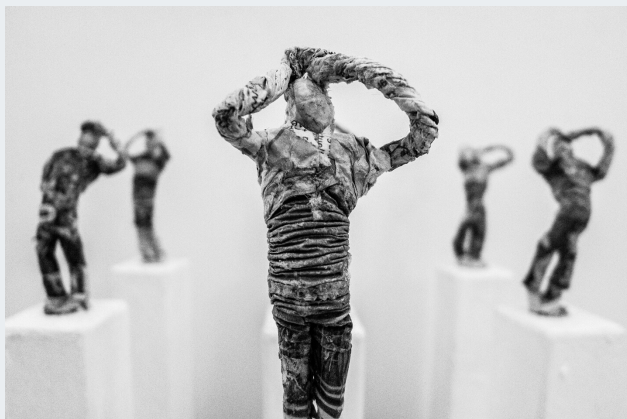
Panama Molas

The Mola, or Molas, is a hand-made textile that forms part of the traditional women's clothing of the Kuna people from Panamá. Design your own molas using fabric and fabric paint. Paverpol is an environmentally friendly fluid used to make fabric rock hard. Drape or wrap fabric around a wire figure and leave it to dry to create a sculpture. Drop in program for 11 and up.

Make a mini-universe with epoxy resin. Paint the rings of Saturn or the red skies of Mars. In the end, you will hold the universe in your hand.
